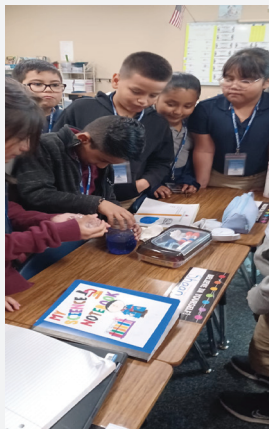

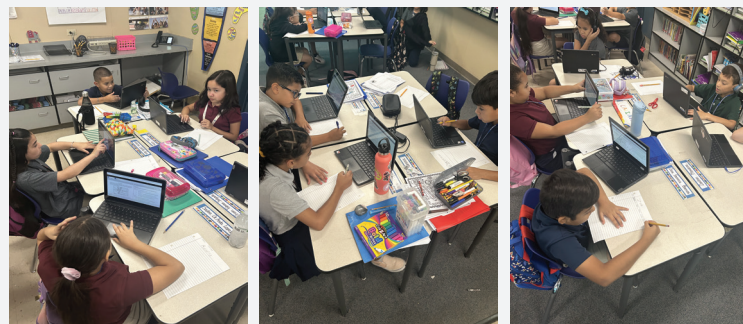

The Digital Dust Devils spent the past month learning about online safety and created slide-shows and flip videos to showcase their knowledge! Staying safe online is a top priority for our school!



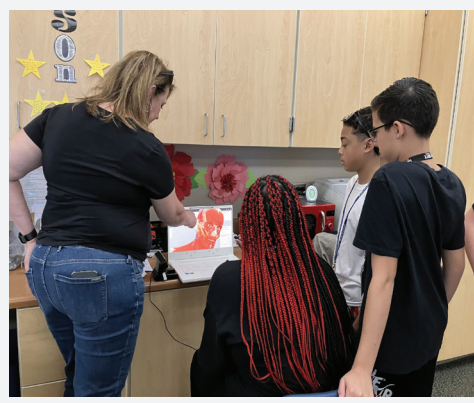
QUENTIN'S BASKETBALL & FOOTBALL TEAMS
