Ms. Thompson's 1st-grade math class is exploring the concepts of more and fewer, focusing on subtraction using

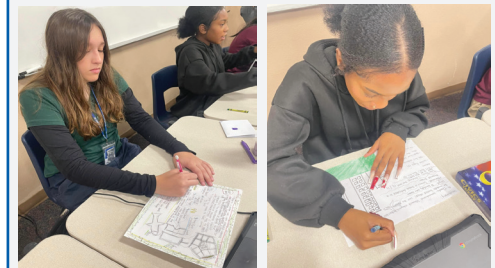


LIGHTHOUSE ACTION TEAM

INSPIRING MEMORIES

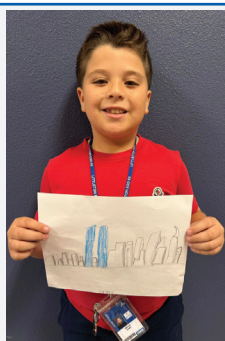


Students created inspiring 9/11 memories in their classes, highlighting the resilience and hope that emerges from tragedy.
