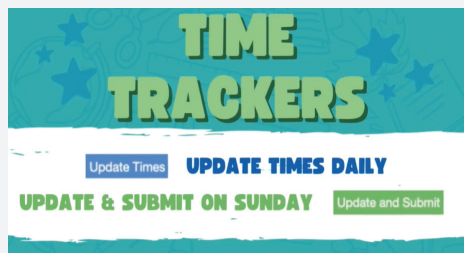
## CURRICULUM DAY & HERITAGE PARADE

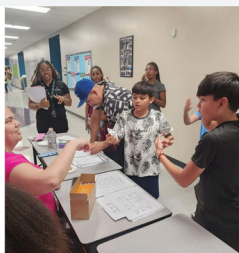
## ATTENDANCE STUDENTVUE & TIME TRACKER
