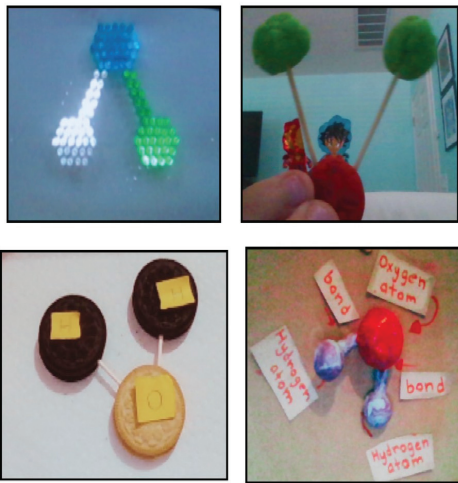
## HISPANIC HERITAGE SPIRIT WEEK
