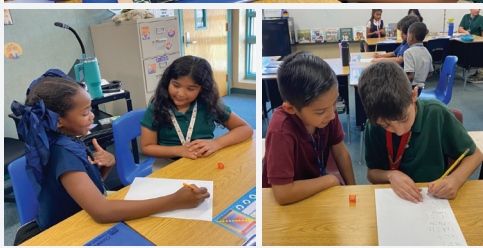

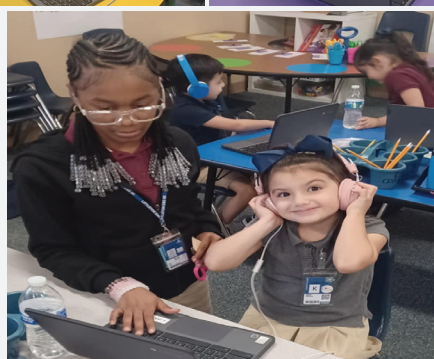
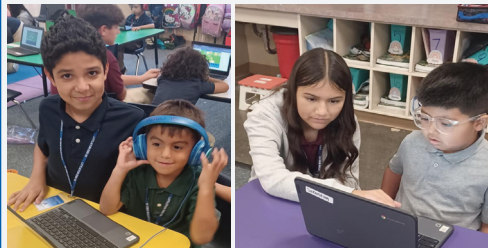
Dice-in-Dice Fun

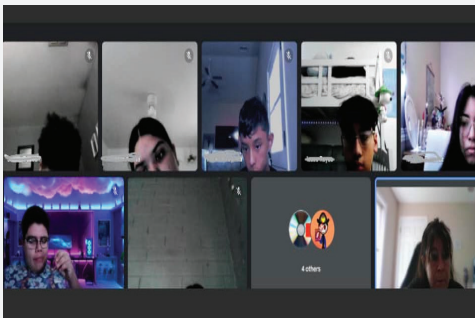
SAFETY FIRST

6th, 7th, and 8th graders at LESD Online Academy are working hard to achieve all they can in Dreambox Reading Plus.

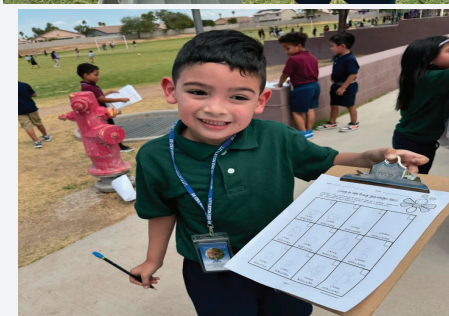

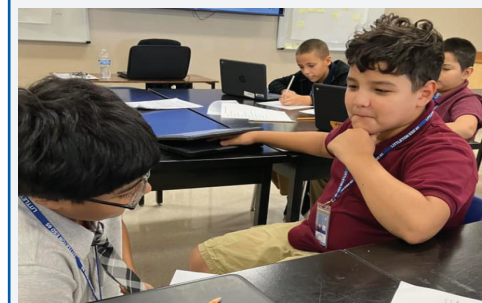
Living and Non-Living Worlds
