Our lady Mustangs took home the win last week against Collier with a score of 22-19. Congratulations on an undefeated season so far!

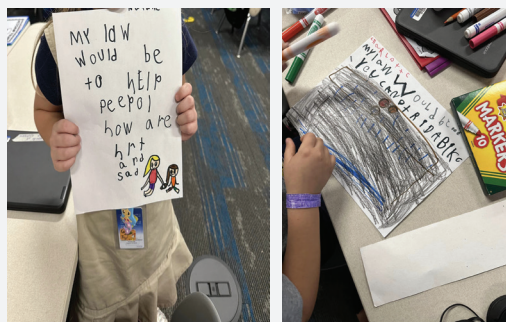
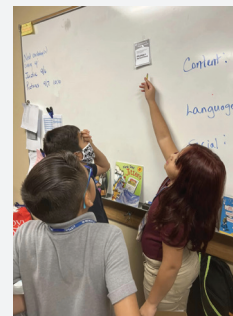
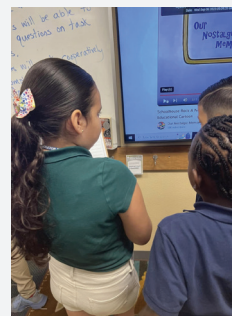
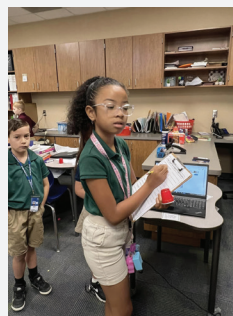
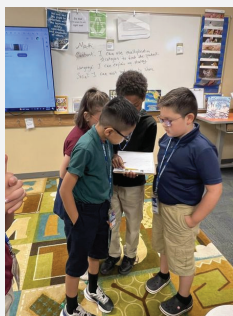
LEARNING ABOUT PHONICS AND ALL THINGS E.Q.
