**Enrollment** – Total enrollment 322 PK – 12<sup>th</sup> grade.

**Projects** – JFK HVAC waiting on the funding to come in for the School Facilities board.

Fields are ongoing.

JFK – We had a response from Kids Closet. She stated they worked with 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> grades and their teachers and staff. They were great well behaved, respected kids. Our 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> grades will be attending Kids Closet on February 13<sup>th</sup> and 1<sup>st</sup> Grade going on February 27<sup>th</sup>.

Superintendent Events – Mr. Duarte and I attended the Copper Corridor meeting on January 27<sup>th</sup>. Webinar on student and mental health on January 28<sup>th</sup>. ### SJSHS Principal William Duarte

Academics – Senior Class check-ins 18 out of 19 students are on tract to graduate. Superioris a leader in the Copper Corridor for FASFA completion. We have 63% of the Senior class that has completed the FASFA application. The state of AZ average is 18%, so we have blown that out of the water again. Seniors are still currently applying for scholarships at this time. Juniors or Seniors that want to take the ACT are busy prepping for that test. We reached out to UofA to help implement partnership between the University and the school. NAU Occupational Therapy department will be promoting to our students this month to promote the program. CAC is going to be here in the coming days to help the students with their Summer and Fall classes that they are interested in taking for the current and future. The welding program currently has 9 students participating. College Knowing and Growing is another partnership that continues to help with FASFA completion and college admissions.

Board member Navarrette asked if all the Seniors have taken the ACT. Principal Duarte stated that they have. Board member Denogean asked if the school offers practice testing for ACT's. Principal Duarte stated they are working on that.
