Dr. Sonia Bribiescas

Dr. Bribiescas brings 30 years of experience in public education, including service as a teacher, instructional specialist, assistant principal and principal. She most recently served as assistant principal and athletic director at Walker Butte K-8 School in Florence Unified School District.

She previously served as principal of the Leadership Academy of Excellence and Florence Virtual Academy. Dr. Bribiescas holds a Doctor of Education in educational leadership from Northern Arizona University and maintains Arizona superintendent and principal certification.

A graduate of Superior High School, she has remained active in the community through service with the Superior High School Hall of Fame and other local organizations.

Dr. Erika Copeland

Dr. Copeland currently serves as associate superintendent of Queen Creek Unified School District, where she provides executive leadership and oversight for principals and district leaders.

She previously served as assistant superintendent and executive director overseeing instructional programs, professional development, strategic planning and district operations. Dr. Copeland holds a doctorate in educational leadership from Northern Arizona University and maintains Arizona superintendent and principal certification.

She brings more than 28 years of experience in K-12 education, including nine years as an elementary principal.
