With the school year quickly approaching, I would like to share with you some updates and changes in regard to the 2023-2024 school year.

Please welcome Ms. Aimee Gaton to the building as she will be the new Health Aide. Additionally, Mrs. Gina Schreiber has taken over the Athletic Director responsibilities for the district. Best of luck to both in their new positions!

Students entering 9th grade this year will be required to complete 44 hours of Community Service to meet graduation requirements, with 11 or more hours needing to be completed yearly. For current 11-12th graders, the total number of Community Service hours required is 39 hours. All 9th-12th grade students will also need to complete two job shadows prior to graduation.
