Noninstructional Operations Policy Guiding Principles

The Board adopts policies governing noninstructional aspects of its operations. In doing so, the Board prioritizes the following principles, aims, and values:

1. Because resources are limited, all assets of District operations, including non-instructional support services, shall be carefully managed to obtain maximum efficiency and economy;
2. The District will seek innovative ways to support the instructional program that maximize the resources directly available for student learning programs;
3. The physical safety and wellbeing of District students is among the District's most important responsibilities;
4. Programs that support education help to provide all students with an equal opportunity to succeed;
5. Noninstructional services shall be conducted in ways that best support the learning environment and meet student needs while maintaining the integrity of the District's Mission.
