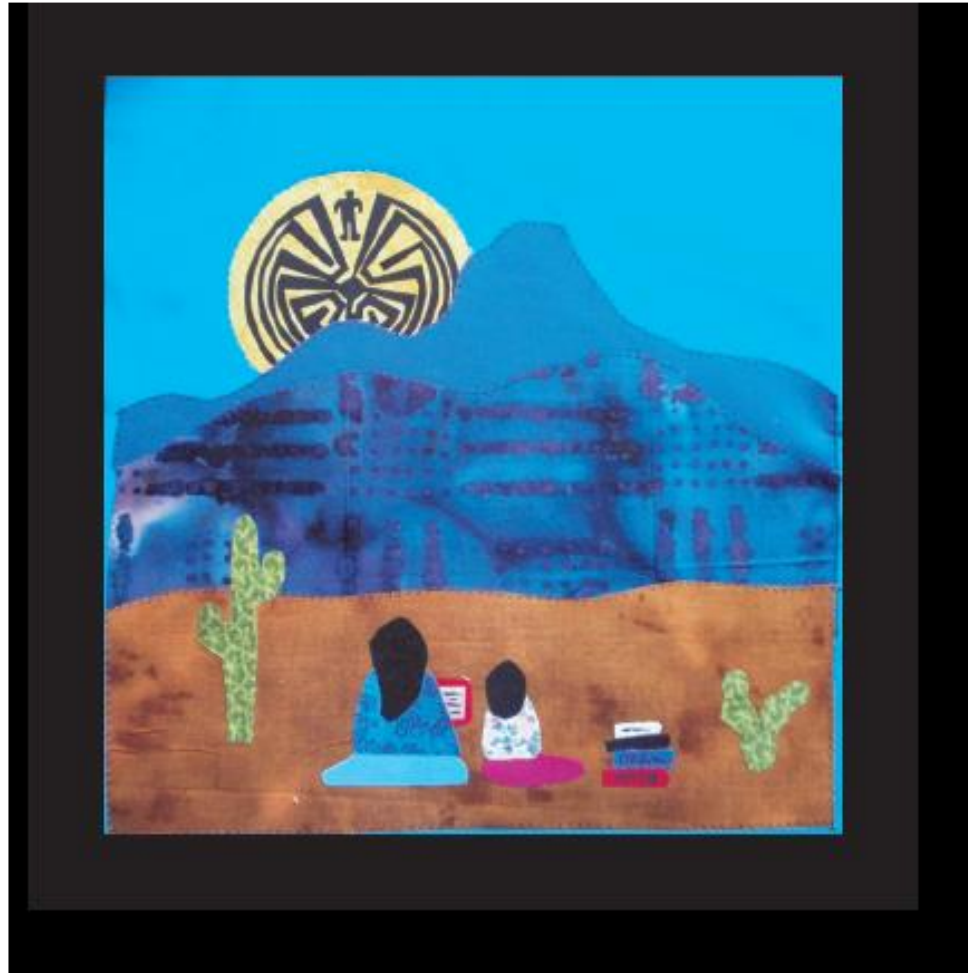


**TOHONO O'ODHAM KEKEL HA-MAŞCAMAKUĐ:  
TOCC GRADUATES FROM 2001 THROUGH 2023**



The quilt block on the cover was made by TOCC employees who were student participants in TOCC's *Wisdom from the Desert* grant program. The program was supported by a *Woksape Oyate–Wisdom of the People* grant from the Lilly Endowment to the American Indian College Fund (AICF). The AICF awarded funding to the tribal colleges that applied for the grant. At the end of the project the tribal colleges reported on how the grant improved the college's intellectual capital and educational capacity at a final conference. As part of the meeting each college presented a quilt square representing its college. The TOCC square represented the College and its growth because of the grant. It symbolizes a meeting of the TOCC Woksape Oyate scholars on Baboquivari Mountain. It shows elements of the Tohono O'odham desert environment and culture, with the Man in the Maze design illustrating life's cycle in the background and in the foreground knowledge being passed from one generation to the next. Squares from the tribal college grantees were made into a quilt that was given to the Lilly Endowment by the AICF as a thank you for the grant funding.

## TOCC GRADUATES 2001 THROUGH 2023

Tohono O’odham Community College (TOCC) is honored to have provided the means for over 800 students to receive associate degrees, certificates, and General Education Diplomas (GEDs) during its 25-year history. The graduates demonstrate the success of the commitment of the Tohono O’odham Nation to provide a fully accredited institution of higher education on the Nation, enabling its members to earn post-secondary degrees in a local, culturally appropriate setting. TOCC is fulfilling its Vision: *“Our vision is to become the Tohono O’odham Nation’s center for higher education, and to enhance the Nation’s participation in the local, state, national, and global communities”* and its Mission: *“As an accredited and land-grant institution, TOCC’s mission is to enhance the unique Tohono O’odham Himdag by strengthening individuals, families, and communities through holistic, quality higher education services. These services will include research opportunities and programs that address academic, life, and development skills”*.

From 2000 through 2004 TOCC provided higher education courses as a site of Pima Community College (PCC) while it completed the requirements for accreditation. TOCC received accreditation in February 2005 and the May 2005 graduates received their degrees from TOCC from that year forward.

Following are the numbers of students receiving degrees, certificates, and General Equivalency Diploma (GED)s beginning in May 2000 the first year that courses were offered by TOCC after it was established in 1998. Some students who began their studies at PCC completed their degrees in 2001 as TOCC students. The list also includes the students who received bachelor’s and master’s degrees from the University of Arizona (UA) through collaborative grants awarded to TOCC.

2001: 8 associate degrees.

2002: 10 associate degrees, 3 certificates, 10 GEDs, TOCC/UA Project NATIVE graduates: 2 bachelor’s degrees.
